

### GENESIS OF CAHFSA

- The WTO-SPS Agreement which obliges Members of the WTO to "address the
  protection of human, animal and plant health through the implementation of
  internationally recognized health and food safety practices and systems."
- The Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas which obliges Member States to "create an efficient and effective regime of sanitary and phytosanitary measures and to harmonize their laws and administrative practices to effect such a regime."

## AGREEMENTS ESTABLISHING CAHFSA

The following Agreements give force to CAHFSA:

- Revised Agreement Establishing the Caribbean Agricultural Health and Food Safety Agency (CAHFSA): February 25, 2011;
- Original Agreement Establishing the Caribbean Agricultural Health and Food Safety Agency (CAHFSA): March 12, 2010

### MODE OF OPERATION

CAHFSA is governed by a Board of Directors made up of one representative from each Member State representing the specialized areas of focus of CAHFSA.

Associate members can attend Board Meetings but cannot vote. Only Board members have the right to vote.

The Secretary General of CARICOM is granted observer status on the Board.

The Board reports annually to the COTED

The day-to-day operations of CAHFSA is managed by a Chief Executive Officer and three (3) Heads of departments

### MANDATE

perform a coordinating and organizing role in the establishment of an effective and efficient regional sanitary and phytosanitary (SPS) regime;

execute on behalf of Member States such SPS actions and activities that can be more effectively and efficiently executed through a regional mechanism.

"To be a leading regional institution of international repute in the application of Agricultural Health and Food Safety Systems."
